



THE STATE-OF-THE-ART IN SCIENTIFIC WRITING AND PUBLICATION

This short course aims to expose young Sub-Saharan African scholars to and strengthen their capacity in the rudiments of scientific writing and publication. The proposed course has in-built practical sessions to equip the participants with the necessary skills and tools to carry out their emergent academic work, develop and sustain academic careers and contribute to international knowledge production.

The course involves lectures, small group discussions, individual practical exercises, take-home assignments, presentation of work samples and peer review
